- **Global Applicability:** The program spans food and fiber sectors, ensuring relevance across diverse crops, regions, and supply chains.
- **Economic Viability:** Transition models are supported by cost-sharing mechanisms and market partnerships to reduce the burden on farmers.





• **Equivalency Standards:** Regenagri provides criteria for soil health, animal welfare, and social fairness strengthened over time until ROC™ is achieved.
